

# **49<sup>th</sup> Annual Kerrville Folk Festival    Oct. 8 – 18, 2020**

## **CRAFT VENDOR INFORMATION**

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

Within the Kennedy Outdoor Theater area, the KFF Crafts Village offers over 50 arts and crafts booths by way of a juried show. Strong preferential consideration is given to vendors who produce and sell hand-crafted items (as opposed to mass-manufactured items or imports). New applicants must provide a website link or directly email photographs that represent the quality and variety of your work. *A Texas Sales Tax ID Number is required to vend in the KFF Crafts Village. For Texas sales tax information and forms call (800) 252-5555.*

### **CRAFT VILLAGE DATES & TIMES**

The Crafts Village is located in the Kennedy Outdoor Theater, which is open 3 afternoons and 8 evenings of the Festival: **Thurs. 10/8 – Sun. 10/11; Thurs. 10/8 – Sun. 10/11** from 6PM until the end of the music (usually about midnight) and in the mid-week **Mon 10/12 – Wed. 10/14 (12pm – 3pm)**. ALL CRAFT BOOTHS must be open and staffed on each of the 8 performance nights at Kennedy Outdoor Theater.

### **BOOTH & VENDING INFORMATION**

Craft Village booths are either 8'x8' or 10'x10'. They are fairly rustic (permanent) structures of "pole barn" type construction, tin roofs, and wooden floors. Each booth comes with a light fixture and access to an electrical outlet. Additional lighting is advised.

**10 ft. x 10 ft. booth - \$550**

**8 ft. x 8 ft. booth - \$450**

### **Application Deadline: August 15, 2020**

Vendor acceptance confirmation and booth assignments will happen the following week. All booth fees must be paid in full by 8/15/20. Booth fees include two 11-day wristbands to the Festival, free access to tent camping and free parking in the parking lot. There are no refunds after booths have been assigned.

There are no guarantees of booth location, however an effort is made to fulfill specific booth requests if possible. To maximize the chances of being assigned a specific booth, return a completed application and provide the full booth fee to the Festival Office by August 7, 2020. *Annual booth occupants should apply and pay by Aug 7, 2020 to ensure a preferred booth assignment.*

### **CHECK-IN**

Vendors may set up their booth beginning at 12PM on Wednesday, Oct 7th. A Volunteer Craft Coordinator will meet Vendors at their booth on Thursday afternoon after 1 PM to issue wristbands. ALL VEHICLES MUST be removed from Kennedy Outdoor Theater by 3:30 PM on any performance day, no exceptions. Booths should be ready for business when Theater gates open at 6 PM on Thursday Oct. 8th.

### **CRAFT VILLAGE SECURITY**

Security Volunteers provide 24-hour security in the Craft Village area beginning the evening of Thursday, Oct.8th, until MIDNIGHT SUNDAY, OCT. 18th. The Festival is not responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged goods, so please secure all valuables.

### **PROHIBITED SALE ITEMS**

Nothing may be displayed that would be construed as drug paraphernalia (even if it's technically "legal"). Nothing may be displayed or sold that contains any amount of explosive material, including party poppers or fireworks. No weapons of any kind are allowed to be displayed or sold, not even toy weapons. While the controlled burning of incense, scented candles, etc. remains allowed in the Craft Village, there are strict limitations; contact the Festival Office for more details.

### **CAMPING**

Campground access is included with booth fees. Absolutely no camping in the Craft Village booths. The campground has toilet facilities and hot showers. Electricity in the campground is available first come/first serve by permit for \$6-\$18/day (depending on a/c). Parking in the parking lot is free; campground parking is by permit only (see website); NO PETS or recorded music are allowed at the Festival. Early camping is available starting Saturday, Oct. 3rd for \$5 per day per 10'x10' campsite, (payable when you arrive). No one under 18 years of age may camp without a parent or legal guardian. Vendors must abide by all Festival Campground Rules.
